

DIRECTIONS TO BROADGATE FARM COTTAGES



Sat Nav Our postcode is HU17 8RP – beware it sometimes tells you to pull into our neighbour across the road!

From York & the North

From the York bypass take the A1079 Signposted to Hull – Market Weighton

Remain on this road – you will pass Pocklington & Market Weighton.

At the end of the Market Weighton by-pass (still the A1079) go straight on at the roundabout and up the hill.

You will go through Bishop Burton Village.

As you come to Beverley you will reach a large roundabout. Take the 4th exit onto Killingwoldgraves Lane

Follow this road until you reach the traffic lights (just outside Walkington).

Turn left towards Beverley on the B1230.

You will pass a few houses on the outskirts of the village.

Broadgate Farm Cottages is on the left after the road bends.

From M62 – the West & the South A1, M1, M18

Leave the M62 at the North Cave exit No 38.

At the end of the slip road turn left onto the B1230 and go through the village of North Cave.

After passing the pub and taking a sharp bend to the left you will arrive at a t junction (shop across the road).

Turn right here and proceed out of the village still on the B1230 – beware sharp bends.

Proceed up the hill, at the T junction take a left and then immediate right on to the B1230 signposted Beverley.

Go up another steep hill and follow the road, you will go through the village of Walkington.

Go straight through the village and straight on at the traffic lights at the end of the village towards Beverley.

You will pass a few houses on the outskirts of the village.

Broadgate Farm Cottages is on the left after the road bends.

From Humber Bridge – South East A15

After you have crossed the Humber Bridge (Toll at June 2009 £2.70) take the 2nd exit at the roundabout onto the A164.

You will then keep on the A164

Pass the shopping centre at Willerby (Waitrose, Homebase, petrol stations, Pubs & hotels)

Go straight on at the next roundabout past Total Fitness Gym

Go straight on at the next roundabout (hospitals)

Go straight on at the next roundabout (Skidby)

Take the next left signposted Walkington

Follow the road do not turn off

You will reach the traffic lights at the edge of Walkington Village

Turn right towards Beverley on the B1230

You will pass a few houses on the outskirts of the village.

Broadgate Farm Cottages is on the left after the road bends.

By Train

Beverley is located on the Hull to Scarborough line. A train service from Hull to Beverley runs approximately every 25 minutes.

Local rail operators include Arriva Trains Northern, Hull Trains and GNER.
